Overview

Help GVAL present **Michael R. Zent Healthcare Center: A Safe Space for Children, Teens & Adults in Greater Phoenix** with a *mural for their sanctuary garden space*.

Jewish Family and Children's Service is a non-profit, non-sectarian 501(c) (3) organization dedicated to strengthening the community through quality behavioral health social services, and primary medical care to children, families, and adults. Their approach to care is based on traditional Jewish values, but that does not mean they only serve Jewish families. They provide quality services to people of all faiths that helps strengthen families, resolve conflicts, and cope with everyday living.



Goals

1. **Mural Design Submissions/Suggestions:** A general mural vision of an extended garden. The board agrees that the mural should both mirror and carry forward a more lush version of the garden's future self. The garden assists counselors in helping clients see a pathway forward to better circumstances for their lives. No other agenda will be used.
2. **Finalize Mural Creation Schedule and Volunteer Sign-Ups:** With our completed mural submission to the Center, we will be offering our design along with our board agreed pricing. GVAL will be managing any necessary supplies including paints and equipment (except what the Center may have available.)

Selection Process

The GVAL Board will have the final say on the design and its approval. **Adjustments may/will be made based on requests from the Michael R. Zent Healthcare Center and the Board.**

Work Size

Approximately 12 ft high x 36 ft wide. The tall grey wall featured to the right of this photograph.



Mural Design Submission Requirements

1. Sample Images

Samples must be high quality and full color - explaining, in detail, the design elements of the mural design. Three to Four JPEG, High Resolution, Scans, and/or Photographs of your design idea. The design must be emailed to gval.sfaa@yahoo.com. Original, new designs only.

2. Must Be Inline With Vision

See "Goals, Section 1" - The garden is beautiful with tall sunflowers, and vegetable varieties, planted by families and clients. Our mural needs to be something giving hope, accenting a pathway leading to a better future.

3. Please List Any Supply Requirements

If a particular color is needed, a ladder, painters tape, etc it needs to be listed. The supply list can be labeled on the Sample Images or in a separate document.
