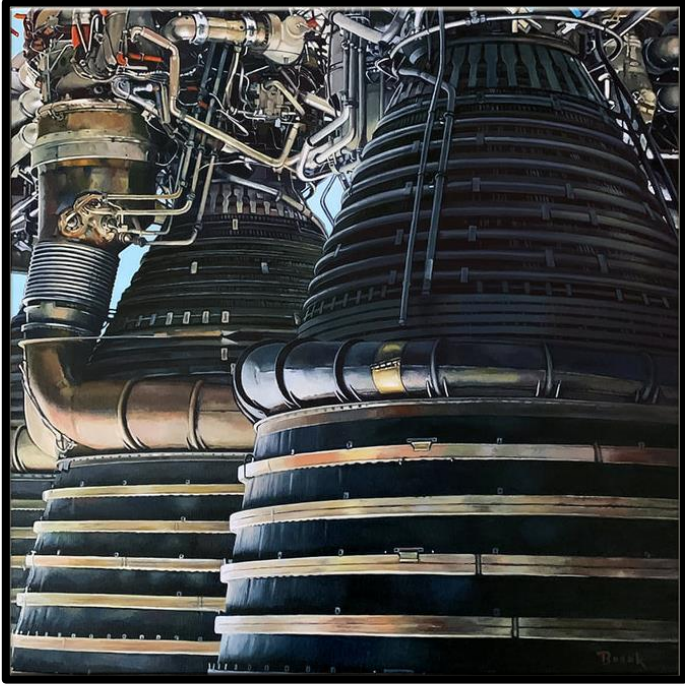


# ARTIST SPOTLIGHT ON HENRY BOSAK
