



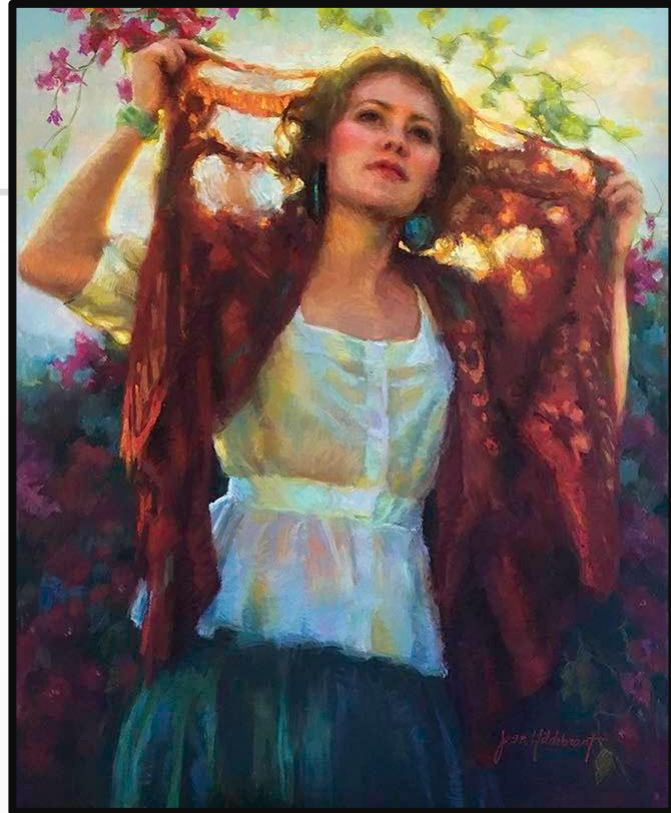

ARTIST SPOTLIGHT ON PETER EOBBI

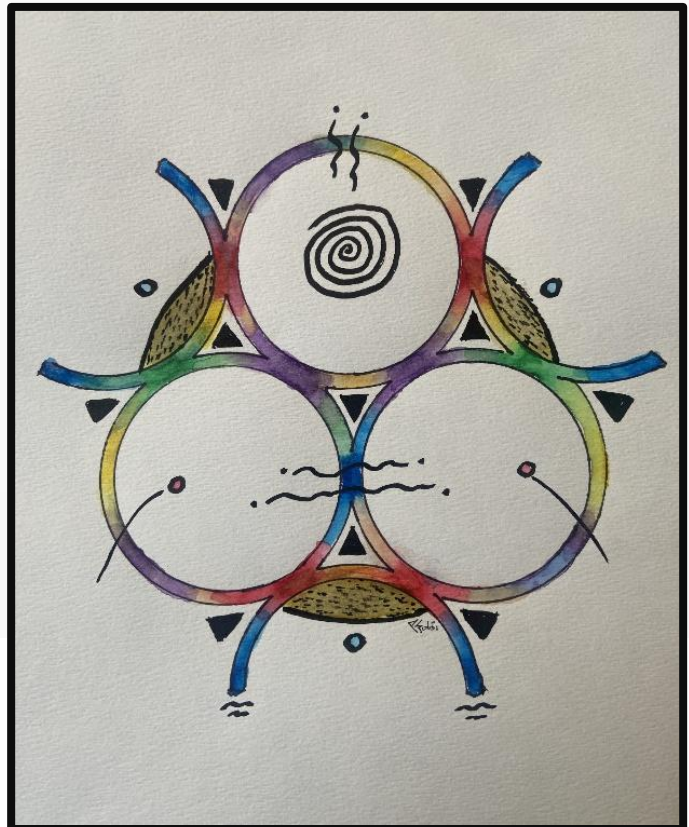
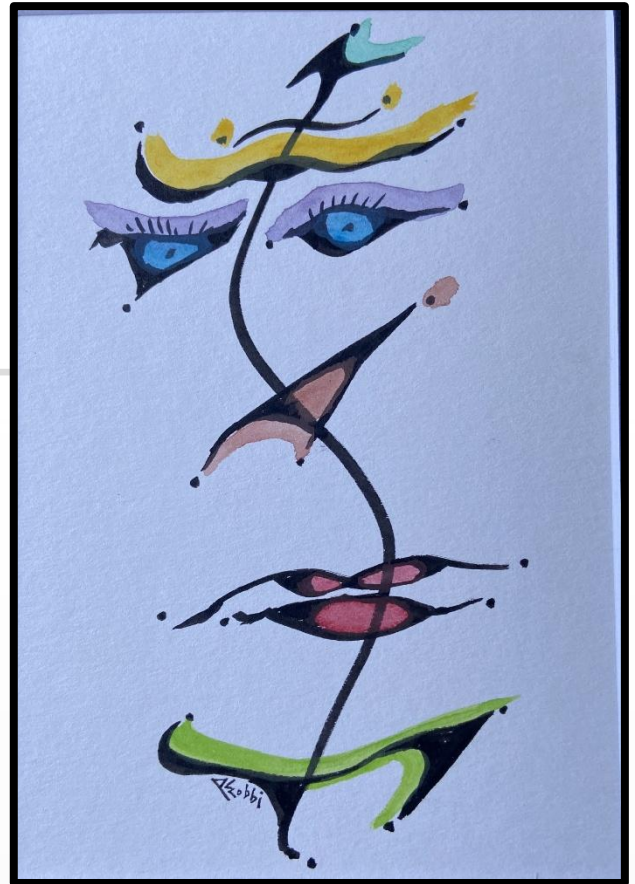
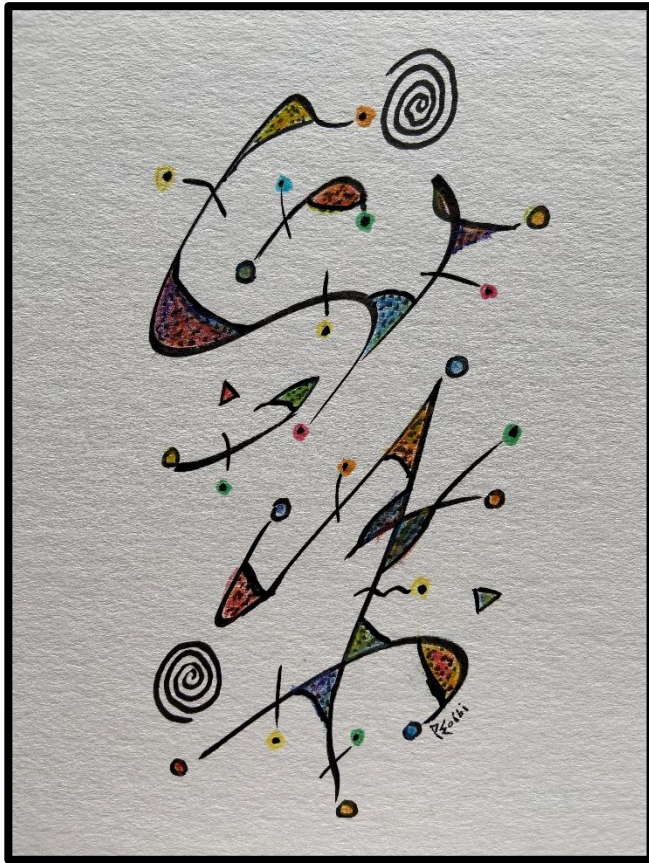
